


Quality Assurance Survey Results Sept. - Dec 2022

These survey results highlight ArcGNO's impact on members' lives.

Here are some key takeaways:

Residential Support Service Members:

56% of members report that ArcGNO helps them access community resources.



Group Employment Members:

When asked, "What do you like best about your job?" one member replied: "I get a chance to communicate with others."

Community Integration Members:

80% report that ArcGNO staff support them in reaching their goals.
91% report that ArcGNO staff treat them with respect
